



UCA Rules

Rules for Ultimate Cheer All-Stars ASBL , a cheerleading program.

The present rules have been written in line with the statuses and adopted by the general assembly held on the 11th of June 2017. A copy is given to all members, and the present rules apply to all. A copy of this document is annexed to the statuses.

A- UCA members

To become an affiliate member of UCA, each applicant needs to fill out and sign the registration form and the rules.

The applicant also needs to pay the yearly registration fees. The amount is decided every year by the board. The fee is non refundable after the end of October, and partially refundable, upon written request, if athletes decide to leave UCA before the end of October.

Members commit to taking part in all activities organised by Ultimate Cheer and to fully comply with UCA's statuses and with the present rules.

B- Practices

Presence at practice is mandatory. Cheerleading is a team sport; therefore the absence of even one athlete has negative consequences for the whole team.

Athletes commit to arriving on time at practice.

In case of an absence or of lateness, athletes are required to tell their coach as soon as possible, so that they can modify practice accordingly, and in any case at least 24h in advance.

For athletes who are part of the competition team, no absence will be authorised in the two weeks leading to a competition.

Coaches can add extra practices during the weeks prior to a competition.

Excessive unexcused absences can be sanctioned.

Excused Absences:

- ★ sickness
- ★ Family emergency
- ★ School exams
- ★ Holidays (planned by UCA)

Unexcused Absences:

- ★ Too much homework
- ★ Traffic Jams
- ★ Tiredness
- ★ Holidays (outside of those planned by UCA)

E-Confidentiality

Ultimate cheer has subscribed to a contract with private insurance company Ethias for the coverage of all athletes and staff during practices, competitions and events. The provisions of our contract can be sent to members who wish to consult them.

Ultimate Cheer will not communicate members' personal information to any third person or company. In the same way, members of Ultimate Cheer will not communicate personal information about other members to anyone.

Members of the association will not communicate to anyone other members' personal information acquired through their Ultimate Cheer membership.

Non compliance to the rules stated above could lead to sanctions:

- ★ 1st infraction : Meeting with the athlete.
- ★ 2nd infraction : Meeting with the athlete + their parents (for minors).
- ★ 3rd infraction : Athlete could be removed from team or program.
